1. Ensure that all learners with computer access at home have downloaded the CodeJIKA curriculum, [Project 1](#), [Project 2](#), and [Project 3](#).

2. If you are using a computer or laptop, please ensure that you have Notepad ++ (every computer comes with it already installed). If you are using a tablet or cell phone download Dcoder (you will find it in the play store), this will allow you to code.

3. Install Adobe Reader (Every PC should have a program that can view PDFs.) and Internet Browser (You don't need internet, but you need a browser. Any browser will work; Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Opera or Safari.)
